Thank you for providing us with the relevant information on the control measures taken against the avian influenza outbreaks in Kaunas county in Lithuania.


I am hereby pleased to inform you that the import suspension of meat and egg products derived from poultry (chicken, quail, ostrich, turkey, pheasant, guinea fowl and birds classified into anseriformes order) from this county has been lifted as of 10th June 2021, as a result of the risk assessment based on the information provided.

Therefore, following commodities from this county have become eligible for export to Japan.

- a) Poultry meat derived from poultry slaughtered on and after 10th June 2021, and their products
- b) Eggs laid on and after 10th June 2021, and their products
