**Import Resumption of Poultry (Carcass, Parts and Offal) and  
Poultry Products (Including Eggs) for Human Consumption  
from Kaunas County, Republic of Lithuania into HKSAR**

Thank you for providing us with information regarding the latest Avian Influenza (AI) situation in **Kaunas County, Republic of Lithuania** dated 27 April of 2021. I am pleased to inform you that we will resume processing application for the importation of poultry (carcass, parts and offal) and poultry products (including eggs) from the **Kaunas County, Republic of Lithuania** with effect from the date of this letter, noting the conditions in paragraph 2.

We will only accept fresh/frozen poultry meat and poultry products, the entire consignment of which come from poultry kept in a country, zone or compartment, free from Avian Influenza (AI) since they were hatched or for at least the past 21 days. Consignments of poultry eggs (produced/packed) for human consumption will only be accepted from an AI free country, zone or compartment and transported in new or appropriately sanitized packaging materials.

The consignment must be accompanied by a health certificate of agreed format currently in use for accompanying the export consignments from
